Basic and Voluntary Life Insurance; Voluntary Long-Term Disability; Basic and Voluntary Accidental Death & Dismemberment; Short-Term Disability; Family Medical Leave Administration and other Administrative Services

Topic

This Action Item requests approval to enter into a contract with Symetra Life Insurance Company (Symetra) for a bundle of products and services which include Basic and Voluntary Life Insurance; Short-Term Disability (STD); Voluntary Long-Term Disability (LTD); Basic and Voluntary Accidental Death and Dismemberment (AD&D); Family Medical Leave Administration (FMLA) and other Administrative Services for eligible employees. The term of the contract will be three (3) years, and the total contract amount for the three (3) year term is estimated at \$4,083,830.87 of which an estimation of \$641,051.10 is paid directly by Citizens with the balance paid by employees electing the benefit. The employee enrollment will fluctuate over the term of the contract, which will determine the contract spend. This contract replaces existing services provided by New York Life.

History

Gallagher Benefit Services, Inc., (Gallagher), Citizens' competitively procured insurance broker, negotiated on Citizens' behalf, and requested competitive quotes from nine national vendors, including the incumbent. Eight quotes from vendors were received and evaluated by Gallagher. Gallagher recommended Citizens negotiate with the top two vendors. Following negotiations, Symetra was identified and recommended by Gallagher as the vendor who provides the greatest value to Citizens offering additional administrative services and a decrease of 6.67% over our current contract pricing. Furthermore, there are no increases to employee contribution rates.

Established in 1957, Symetra Life Insurance Company is a direct subsidiary of Symetra Financial Corporation. Symetra received an "A" rating from AM Best rating systems. Headquartered in Bellevue, WA., Symetra Financial Corporation is a diversified financial services company with \$58.6 billion in assets as of December 31, 2022, approximately 1.7 million customers and over 2,000 employees nationwide. It is traded on the New York Stock Exchange under the symbol "SYA."

Citizens estimates the portion of its' cost to be \$641,051.10 for the 100% company-paid coverage plans and services for Basic Life, Basic AD&D, STD, FMLA and other Administrative Services. Estimated cost for the employee paid portion is \$3,442,779.77 for the 100% employee-paid plans that provide Voluntary Life, Voluntary AD&D, and Voluntary LTD policies.

This cost assumes 1,448 participating employees. Participation in these coverages will be determined during open enrollment each year. A five (5) percent contingency amount has been added to allow for potential fluctuation of participating employees.

Recommendation

Citizens' Staff proposes that the Board of Governors:

- a) Approve a three (3) year contract with Symetra Life Insurance Company for Basic and Voluntary Life Insurance; STD and Voluntary LTD; Basic and Voluntary AD&D; FMLA and other Administrative Services for \$641,051.10 paid by Citizens and \$3,442,779.77 paid by employees, for an estimated total contract amount of \$4,083,830.87, and,
- b) Authorize staff to take any appropriate or necessary action consistent with this Action Item.
