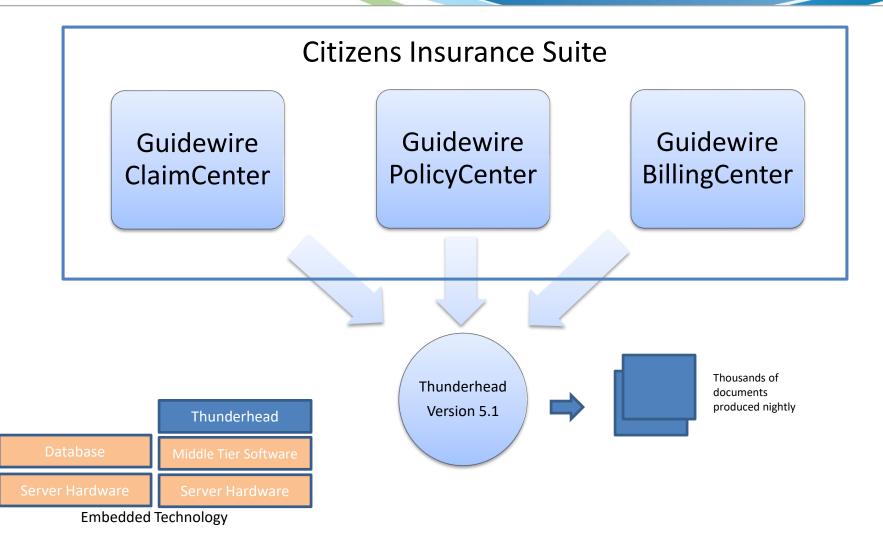

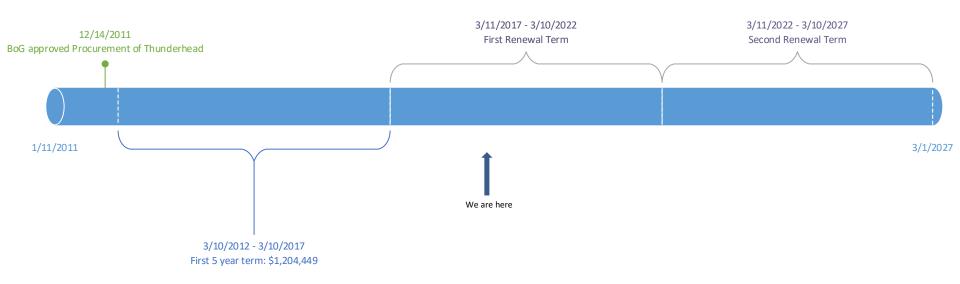

#### **Procurement Timeline**

#### Cost of the two 5 year renewals combined: \$1,187,488



#### Board approved Spend for all three terms combined: \$2,391,937



#### What is Changing?

- Version 5.1 of the software we are using today is the onpremises version that must be installed on our hardware and must be hosted within our data center.
- <u>The company has stopped supporting on-premises version</u> <u>of the software</u>.
- Options :
  - 1. Upgrade to the last on-premises version (6.1) of the software and run it through the end of second renewal with support from the vendor (March 2022)
  - 2. Migrate to the cloud version of the software known as SmartComm. The additional spend associated with this migration is \$917,682.
  - 3. Replace the software vendor.

# Upgrade to the cloud version of the software (SmartComm)



How did we arrive at the recommendation?

- Embedded Technology integrated deeply within the insurance suite. Hundreds of templates exist.
- This option is more economical in the long run. We have a business case comparing Option 1 (staying with the on premises version of the software) vs. Option 2 (going to the cloud version).
- The cloud version offers additional functional capabilities.

  - Is SmartComm a Guidewire Official Certified partner? YES
  - Is SmartComm cost consistent with the other state term contract vendors? YES
